Please be advised that while we have accepted all of the recommendations of the Conciliation Board, a collective agreement is not yet concluded.

As of 00:01hours July 2, 2002 the CFPA membership will be in a legal strike position.

It is the intention of the CFPA to initiate job action against the employer effective July 2, 2002. The employer can initially expect a "work to rule" plan to commence and a restriction of the performance of duties to normal working hours only.

The CFPA remains available to the employer to meet and resolve the outstanding issues for which the Conciliation Board made no recommendation.
